ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

Paragraph

- 1. Citation and commencement
- 2. Exemption

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 36 of the Architects Act, the Minister for National Development makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order is the Architects (Exemption from Practising Certificates) Order 2017 and comes into operation on 6 October 2017.

Exemption

2. Part V of the Act does not apply to —

- (*a*) a foreign architect registered under section 15(2A) of the Act to supply, or offer to supply, architectural services in Singapore only in collaboration with a registered architect who has in force a practising certificate; or
- (b) a foreign architect registered under section 15(1)(c) of the Act and to whom the Architects (Exemption from Experience Requirements) Order 2017 (G.N. No. S 567/2017) applies.
