ACTIVE MOBILITY (REGISTRABLE PERSONAL MOBILITY DEVICES) ORDER 2019

ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

Paragraph

1. Citation and commencement
 2. What is a registrable personal mobility device
-

In exercise of the powers conferred by the definition of “registrable personal mobility device” in section 2(1) of the Active Mobility Act 2017, the Minister for Transport makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order is the Active Mobility (Registrable Personal Mobility Devices) Order 2019 and comes into operation on 2 January 2019.

What is a registrable personal mobility device

2.—(1) A personal mobility device is a registrable personal mobility device if the device —

- (a) has an electric motor attached to the device; and
- (b) has handlebars.

(2) To avoid doubt, a personal mobility device that meets the description in sub-paragraph (1) is registrable whether or not it has any seat.
