In exercise of the powers conferred by section 66 of the Active Mobility Act 2017, the Minister for Transport makes the following Order:

#### **Citation and commencement**

1. This Order is the Active Mobility (Non-Compliant Vehicle Use — Exemption) Order 2018 and comes into operation on 1 May 2018.

#### **Definitions**

2. In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires —
  - “public park” has the meaning given by section 2 of the Parks and Trees Act (Cap. 216);
  - “specified person” means any person specified in the Schedule;
  - “UEN” means Unique Entity Number.

**Exemption from section 19(1)(a) and (c) of Act**

3.—(1) Section 19(1)(a) of the Act does not apply to an individual who rides on any footpath or shared path within a public park, a non-compliant bicycle that is rented from a specified person.

(2) Section 19(1)(c) of the Act does not apply to an individual who rides on any footpath or shared path within a public park, a non-compliant personal mobility device that —

(a) is non-motorised; and

(b) is rented from a specified person.
