# ACTIVE MOBILITY (CYCLING WITHOUT AGE — EXEMPTION) ORDER 2021

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 66 of the Active Mobility Act 2017, the Minister for Transport makes the following Order:

#### Citation and period in force

**1.**—(1) This Order is the Active Mobility (Cycling Without Age — Exemption) Order 2021.

(2) This Order is in force for the period between 8 September 2021 and 31 March 2027 (both dates inclusive).

# Definitions

2. In this Order —

"CWA Singapore" means the company incorporated under the Companies Act (Cap. 50) as Cycling Without Age Singapore Ltd. (UEN 201714757N); "specified e-trishaw" means a three-wheeled pedal cycle that ----

- (a) is constructed or adapted for the carriage of passengers;
- (b) is equipped with an electric motor;
- (c) may be propelled by human power or by the electric motor with which it is equipped, or by both; and
- (*d*) is used by CWA Singapore for the purpose of ferrying individuals;

"specified route" means a route, comprising one or more footpaths or shared paths, that is bounded or delineated by black-coloured lines in the maps set out in the Schedule.

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## Exemption for driving specified e-trishaw

**3.**—(1) Sections 16(1)(b) and 17(1) of the Act do not apply to an individual who drives a specified e-trishaw on any specified route during the driving times and the days of the week mentioned in sub-paragraph (2), under the following conditions:

- (a) the individual has completed a training course conducted by CWA Singapore on how to drive the specified e-trishaw;
- (b) the individual is authorised by CWA Singapore to drive the specified e-trishaw;
- (c) the specified e-trishaw is only used to carry, for their leisure, passengers who belong to any class of passengers that is approved by the Authority to be carried on a specified e-trishaw;
- (d) the specified e-trishaw is not used to carry passengers for hire or reward;
- (e) the individual who drives the specified e-trishaw
  - (i) drives at a speed not exceeding 10 km/h;
  - (ii) does not carry, at any time, more than 2 passengers;

- (iii) drives with all passengers on the specified e-trishaw safely secured;
- (iv) gives way to other users of the footpath or shared path;

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- (v) keeps a distance of at least 50 metres away from
  - (A) any other specified e-trishaw; or
  - (B) (where sub-paragraph (vi) applies) any other group of specified e-trishaws, or any other specified e-trishaw that is not in a group of specified e-trishaws; and

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- (vi) drives the specified e-trishaw on the specified route with other drivers of specified e-trishaws in a group, only if —
  - (A) the specified route is in Part 15 of the Schedule; and
  - (B) the group of specified e-trishaws consists of not more than 3 specified e-trishaws; [S 229/2025 wef 31/03/2025]

(*f*) the specified e-trishaw is accompanied by a safety marshal who ensures the safe use of the specified e-trishaw;

- (g) there is in force, at any time the specified e-trishaw is used, a policy of insurance in relation to the specified e-trishaw insuring against any liability in respect of the death of or bodily injury sustained by any person (other than the driver or any passenger of the specified e-trishaw), or property damage suffered by any person (other than the driver or any passenger of the specified e-trishaw), caused by or arising out of the use of the specified e-trishaw;
- (h) the risk under the policy of insurance mentioned in sub-paragraph (g) is assumed by an insurer who, at the time of the issuance of the policy, is lawfully carrying on an insurance business in Singapore;

- (*i*) no more than the number of specified e-trishaws mentioned in sub-paragraph (3) are used at any time on the specified route.
- (2) The driving times and days of the week are as follows:
  - (a) for the specified routes in Parts 1, 3, 4, 5, 8, 10, 11, 13 and 14 of the Schedule from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. on a weekday, Saturday or Sunday;

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- (b) for the specified routes in Part 2 of the Schedule from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on a weekday, Saturday or Sunday; [S 229/2025 wef 31/03/2025]

  - (c) [Deleted by S 229/2025 wef 31/03/2025]
  - (d) for the specified route in Part 6 of the Schedule
    - (i) from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. on a Saturday, Sunday or weekday (being a public holiday); and
    - (ii) from 9.30 a.m. to 5 p.m. on a day other than a Saturday, Sunday or weekday (being a public holiday);

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- (*da*) for the specified routes in Part 7 of the Schedule from 9.30 a.m. to 5.30 p.m. on a weekday, Saturday or Sunday; [S 418/2023 wef 24/06/2023]
  - (e) for the specified route in Part 9 of the Schedule
    - (i) from 12 p.m. to 3 p.m. on a Saturday, Sunday or weekday (being a public holiday); and
    - (ii) from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. on a day other than a Saturday, Sunday or weekday (being a public holiday);
  - (f) [Deleted by S 229/2025 wef 31/03/2025]
  - (g) [Deleted by S 229/2025 wef 31/03/2025]
  - (*h*) for the specified route in Part 12 of the Schedule from 10 a.m. to 4.30 p.m. on a weekday, Saturday or Sunday; [S 229/2025 wef 31/03/2025]

- (i) for the specified route in Part 13A of the Schedule
  - (i) from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. on a Saturday, Sunday or weekday (being a public holiday); and
  - (ii) from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. on a day other than a Saturday, Sunday or weekday (being a public holiday);

- (j) for the specified route in Part 15 of the Schedule from 9 a.m. to 12 noon and 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. on a weekday, Saturday or Sunday.

(3) The number of specified e-trishaws allowed on each specified route are as follows:

(*a*) for the specified routes in Parts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 13A and 14 of the Schedule — 4;

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(*aa*) for the specified routes in Parts 7 and 12 of the Schedule — 2;

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- (b) for the specified route in Part 9 of the Schedule -1;
- (c) for the specified routes in Parts 10, 11, 13 and 15 of the Schedule — 6.



PART 3 ROUTE A3 Division 1 — Footpath Map A3.1






Division 2 — Shared path Map A3.2


Division 1 - Footpath

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

ROUTE A6 Division 1 — Footpath Map A6.1








PART 14 ROUTE A14 Shared path Map A14.1
