CUSTOMS (DUTIES) (COVID-19 — EXEMPTION) ORDER 2020

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 13(1) of the Customs Act, the Minister for Finance makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order is the Customs (Duties) (COVID-19 — Exemption) Order 2020 and is deemed to have come into operation on 15 April 2020 at 12 noon.

Exemption

2. The importer of any goods specified in the Schedule is exempt from payment of customs duty on those goods.

Application of Order

3. This Order applies despite anything in the Customs (Duties) (Exemption) Order (O 5).

4.	2208.90.40	Other samsu of an alcoholic strength by volume exceeding 40% vol.

In this Schedule, "*HS Code*" means the ASEAN Harmonised Tariff Nomenclature Code (AHTN) published in the document called the Singapore Trade Classification, Customs and Excise Duties (STCCED) that is accessible on the official website of the Singapore Customs.
