#### CURRENCY (DENOMINATIONS AND CHARACTERISTICS OF COINS) NOTIFICATION 2020

Pursuant to section 17(5) of the Currency Act, it is notified for general information that the denominations and characteristics of the coins to be issued on 1 January 2021 by the Monetary Authority of Singapore are as shown in the Schedule.
