The centre coin features a peony with the words “SINGAPORE FIRST ALMANAC COIN SERIES” around it. The denomination “\$10” is above the peony. Each of the 12 coins surrounding the centre coin features the design of the animals depicted in the first Almanac Coin Series. The year of issue of that animal is above the design. The 2 Chinese characters signifying the year of the animal are at the lower-left while the denomination “\$2” is at the lower-right.
