Inspired by Chinese calligraphy, the horse in the centre is symbolised by the appropriate Chinese character of the “Heavenly Stems and Earthly Branches” to enhance the characteristics of the animal and the oriental cultural flavour. The peony, a traditional Chinese symbol of blessings and festive cheer, incorporated on the body of the horse, ushers in the Lunar New Year. The 2 Chinese characters signifying the “Year of the Horse” are at the lower-centre of the design. The denomination of the coin in figures is above the design and the weight in troy oz/grams
