In exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph (b) of the Schedule to the Charities Act, the Minister for Community Development, Youth and Sports hereby makes the following Order:

#### Citation and commencement

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Charities (Exempt Charities) Order 2011 and shall come into operation on 1st March 2011.

## **Institutions**

**2.** The institutions set out in the Schedule, so far as they are charities, have been declared to be exempt charities for the purposes of the Act.

### Revocation

**3.** The Charities (Exempt Charities) (Consolidation) Order (O 1, 1995 Ed.) and the Charities (Exempt Charities) (Consolidation) Order (O 3, 1997 Ed.) are revoked.
