COMMON GAMING HOUSES ACT (CHAPTER 49)

COMMON GAMING HOUSES (EXEMPTION) (NO. 13) NOTIFICATION 2017

ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Common Gaming Houses Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Notification:

Citation

1. This Notification is the Common Gaming Houses (Exemption) (No. 13) Notification 2017.

Exemption

- **2.**—(1) The Minister exempts Marina Bay Sands Pte. Ltd. from the provisions of the Act in respect of
 - (a) the "Marina Bay Sands Top 500 Peel & Win" promotion to be held from 24 March 2017 to 2 April 2017 (both dates inclusive); and
 - (b) the lottery called the "Bingo Draw" to be held as part of that promotion where
 - (i) "Peel & Win" cards are issued at the Top 500 Redemption Counter in the Ruby Room, Casino

- Atrium 2 at Marina Bay Sands from 12 noon to 10 p.m. daily on 1 April 2017 and 2 April 2017; and
- (ii) draws are conducted at the Ruby Room, Casino Atrium 2 at Marina Bay Sands at 6 p.m. daily on 1 April 2017 and 2 April 2017.
- (2) The exemption is subject to compliance by Marina Bay Sands Pte. Ltd. with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 2

CONDITIONS

- The methodology of the promotion, the details of the prizes to be distributed, their manner of distribution and, where the winners are determined solely or partly by a lottery, the time, date and place of the lottery, must be disclosed in printed publicity material, copies of which must be freely available to all participants.
- 2. Only persons in the employment of Marina Bay Sands Pte. Ltd. may conduct a lottery.
- 3. Each lottery must
 - (a) be conducted in public; or
 - (b) if conducted in private by means of a computerised system, be witnessed and audited by a public accountant who is not in the employment of Marina Bay Sands Pte. Ltd.
- 4. A lottery must not involve the use of any game, method, device, scheme or competition declared by the Minister under section 2(3) of the Act to be a lottery or a game of chance or of mixed chance and skill.
- 5. A lottery must not involve the use of any article declared by the Minister under section 2(4) of the Act to be an instrument or appliance for gaming.
- 6. The results of each draw must be publicised at the draw area of the casino at Marina Bay Sands
 - (a) through announcements using the audiovisual system; and
 - (b) through display on plasma television sets.
- 7. Marina Bay Sands Pte. Ltd. must, before the start of the lotteries, undertake to ensure that an audited statement of accounts and the results of the lotteries are sent by registered post to the Head, Specialised Crime Policy Branch, Criminal Investigation Department, no later than 3 July 2017.
