COMMON GAMING HOUSES ACT (CHAPTER 49)

COMMON GAMING HOUSES (EXEMPTION) (NO. 17) NOTIFICATION 2016

ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Common Gaming Houses Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Notification:

Citation

1. This Notification is the Common Gaming Houses (Exemption) (No. 17) Notification 2016.

Exemption

- **2.**—(1) The Minister exempts Marina Bay Sands Pte. Ltd. from the provisions of the Act in respect of
 - (a) the "Kingdom of Gold" promotion to be held from 16 March 2016 to 8 May 2016 (both dates inclusive);
 - (b) the "Daily Kiosk Game" to be held as part of that promotion at all Sands Rewards Club kiosks within the premises of the casino of Marina Bay Sands from 18 March 2016 to 5 May 2016 (both dates inclusive); and
 - (c) the "Finale Lucky Draw" to be held as part of that promotion at the Main Casino Floor (Level B2M) at Marina Bay Sands

in 5 sessions hourly from 6 p.m. to 10 p.m. daily from 6 May 2016 to 8 May 2016 (both dates inclusive).

(2) The exemption is subject to compliance by Marina Bay Sands Pte. Ltd. with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 2

CONDITIONS

- The methodology of the promotion, the details of the prizes to be distributed, their manner of distribution and, where the winners are determined solely or partly by a lottery, the time, date and place of the lottery, must be disclosed in printed publicity material, copies of which must be freely available to all participants.
- 2. Only persons in the employment of Marina Bay Sands Pte. Ltd. may conduct a lottery.
- 3. Each lottery must
 - (a) be conducted in public; or
 - (b) if conducted in private by means of a computerised system, be witnessed and audited by a public accountant who is not in the employment of Marina Bay Sands Pte. Ltd.
- 4. A lottery must not involve the use of any game, method, device, scheme or competition declared by the Minister under section 2(3) of the Act.
- 5. A lottery must not involve the use of any instrument or appliance for gaming declared by the Minister under section 2(4) of the Act.
- 6. The results of each lottery must be announced via the audio-visual system at the draw area, in addition to being displayed on the plasma television sets of the casino at Marina Bay Sands, after the lottery is completed.
- 7. Marina Bay Sands Pte. Ltd. must, before the start of the lotteries, undertake to ensure that an audited statement of accounts and the results of the lotteries are sent by registered post to the Head, Specialised Crime Policy Branch, Criminal Investigation Department, no later than 9 August 2016.
