In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Common Gaming Houses Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Notification:

#### **Citation**

1. This Notification may be cited as the Common Gaming Houses (Exemption) (No. 16) Notification 2015.

#### **Exemption**

2.—(1) The Minister exempts the Singapore Turf Club from the provisions of the Act in respect of —

- (a) the “Japan Bloodhorse Breeders’ Association Lucky Draw” promotion to be held on 5 April 2015; and
- (b) the draw to be held on 13 April 2015 between 2 p.m. and 5 p.m. (Singapore time) at the office of the Japan Bloodhorse Breeders’ Association in Japan.

(2) The exemption is subject to compliance by the Singapore Turf Club with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 2

CONDITIONS

1. The methodology of the promotion, the details of the prizes to be distributed, their manner of distribution and, if the winners are determined solely or partly by a draw, the time, date and place of the draw must be disclosed in printed publicity material, copies of which must be freely available to all participants.
2. The Singapore Turf Club must undertake to ensure that the winners are notified by telephone and post.
3. The Singapore Turf Club must, before the start of the draw, undertake to ensure that an audited statement of accounts and the results of the draw are sent by registered post to the Head, Specialised Crime Policy Branch, Criminal Investigation Department, no later than 14 July 2015.
