# COMMON GAMING HOUSES (EXEMPTION) (NO. 28) NOTIFICATION 2017

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Common Gaming Houses Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Notification:

#### Citation

**1.** This Notification is the Common Gaming Houses (Exemption) (No. 28) Notification 2017.

## Exemption

- **2.**—(1) The Minister exempts SMRT Corporation Ltd (called in this Notification the organiser) from the provisions of the Act in respect of
  - (a) the "SMRT's 30th Anniversary Charity Draw 2017" promotion to be held from 28 June 2017 to 31 August 2017 (both dates inclusive); and

(b) the draw to be held at 4 p.m. on 15 September 2017 at SMRT North Bridge Road Auditorium, 251 North Bridge Road, Singapore 179102.

(2) The exemption is subject to compliance by the organiser with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

### THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 2

#### **CONDITIONS**

- The price of the draw ticket, the name and address of the organiser, and the details of the prizes to be distributed, must be clearly stated on each draw ticket.
- 2. The draw ticket must only be issued by way of sale and upon receipt of its price in full.
- 3. The name, identity card number (if available), contact number and email address (if available) of the purchaser of each draw ticket must be recorded on the counterfoil of that ticket.
- 4. The draw must be conducted
  - (a) by the organiser and its officers only; and
  - (b) in public.
- 5. The organiser must, before the start of the draw, undertake to ensure that an audited statement of accounts and the results of the draw are sent by registered post to the Head, Specialised Crime Policy Branch, Criminal Investigation Department, no later than 16 December 2017.
