In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Common Gaming Houses Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Notification:

Citation

1. This Notification may be cited as the Common Gaming Houses (Exemption) (No. 25) Notification 2012.

Exemption

2.—(1) The Minister hereby exempts Singapore Press Holdings Limited (referred to in this Notification as “the organiser”) from the provisions of the Act in respect of the “Tap & Donate” promotion to be held from 19th July 2012 to 30th September 2012 (both dates inclusive) and the draws to be held at 2.30 p.m. at the Singapore Press Holdings News Centre at 100 Toa Payoh North, Singapore 318994, on each of the following dates:

- (a) 31st July 2012;
- (b) 7th August 2012;
- (c) 14th August 2012;

- (d) 21st August 2012;
- (e) 28th August 2012;
- (f) 4th September 2012;
- (g) 11th September 2012;
- (h) 18th September 2012;
- (i) 25th September 2012;
- (j) 2nd October 2012.

(2) The exemption is subject to compliance by the organiser with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 2

CONDITIONS

1. The methodology of the promotion, the details of the prizes to be distributed, their manner of distribution and, if the winners are determined solely or partly by a draw, the time, date and place of the draw, shall be disclosed in printed publicity material, copies of which shall be freely available to all participants.
2. Every draw shall be conducted by the organiser and its officers only.
3. Every draw shall be conducted in public.
4. Every draw by means of a computerised system which is not conducted in public shall be witnessed and audited by a public accountant who is not an employee of the organiser.
5. Every draw shall not involve the use of any game, method, device, scheme or competition declared by the Minister in a notification under section 2(3) of the Act.
6. Every draw shall not involve the use of any instrument or appliance for gaming declared by the Minister in a notification under section 2(4) of the Act.
7. The organiser shall undertake to ensure that —
 - (a) the results of each draw shall be published in one major newspaper in Singapore within 7 days after the determination of all the winners; and
 - (b) an audited statement of accounts shall, together with the results of the draws, be sent by registered post to the Head, Specialised Crime Policy
