COMMON GAMING HOUSES (EXEMPTION) (NO. 28) NOTIFICATION 2015

ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Common Gaming Houses Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Notification:

Citation

1. This Notification may be cited as the Common Gaming Houses (Exemption) (No. 28) Notification 2015.

Definition

- **2.** In this Notification, "organisers" means
 - (a) the Jalan Besar Division Women's Executive Committee; and
 - (b) the Jalan Besar Active Ageing Committee.

Exemption

3.—(1) The Minister exempts the organisers from the provisions of the Act in respect of —

- (a) the "Jalan Besar Mahjong Championship 2015" promotion to be held from 15 June 2015 to 26 July 2015 (both dates inclusive); and
- (b) the mahjong games to be held at the multi-purpose hall of Geylang West Community Club as part of that promotion from 9.30 a.m. to 4 p.m. on 26 July 2015.
- (2) The exemption is subject to compliance by the organisers with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 3

CONDITIONS

- 1. The only game played must be mahjong.
- 2. All players must be at least 21 years of age and residing in the Moulmein-Kallang Group Representation Constituency or the Whampoa Constituency.
- 3. All spectators and staff must be at least 21 years of age.
- 4. Prize sponsors must not be involved in any business related to gambling.
- 5. Advertising for the mahjong competition must be confined to posters and banners displayed within the Moulmein-Kallang Group Representation Constituency or the Whampoa Constituency.
- 6. The organisers may charge an entrance fee of \$25 to cover the cost of hosting the mahjong competition, less the value of the prizes.
- 7. Token prizes can be allowed in recognition of the skills shown by the winners.
- 8. The organisers must ensure that the rules of the game are explained clearly to all players before the start of the event.
- 9. The organisers must deploy umpires on site to referee the event and resolve any disputes.
- 10. The mahjong activities must be held indoors at the multi-purpose hall of Geylang West Community Club.
- 11. The organisers must ensure that all doors to the multi-purpose hall of Geylang West Community Club are closed during the event so as to minimise noise from the event.

THE SCHEDULE — continued

- 12. The organisers must open up the premises for spot-checks by the police during the event.
- 13. The organisers must take all reasonable steps to ensure that there are no private deals or side-betting throughout the event.
