# COMMON GAMING HOUSES ACT (CHAPTER 49)

## COMMON GAMING HOUSES (EXEMPTION) (NO. 29) NOTIFICATION 2015

#### ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

#### Paragraph

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Common Gaming Houses Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Notification:

#### Citation

1. This Notification may be cited as the Common Gaming Houses (Exemption) (No. 29) Notification 2015.

## Exemption

- 2.—(1) The Minister exempts Marina Bay Sands Pte. Ltd. from the provisions of the Act in respect of the "Mystery Multiplier" promotion to be held from 22 June 2015 to 31 August 2015 (both dates inclusive) at Sands Rewards Club counter at the Main Casino Floor (Level B2M) at Marina Bay Sands.
- (2) The exemption is subject to compliance by Marina Bay Sands Pte. Ltd. with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

#### THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 2

#### **CONDITIONS**

- The methodology of the promotion, the details of the prizes to be distributed, their manner of distribution and, where the winners are determined solely or partly by a lottery, the time, date and place of the lottery, must be disclosed in printed publicity material, copies of which must be freely available to all participants.
- 2. Only persons in the employment of Marina Bay Sands Pte. Ltd. may conduct a lottery.
- 3. Every lottery must
  - (a) be conducted in public; or
  - (b) if conducted in private by means of a computerised system, be witnessed and audited by a public accountant who is not in the employment of Marina Bay Sands Pte. Ltd.
- 4. A lottery must not involve the use of any game, method, device, scheme or competition declared by the Minister under section 2(3) of the Act.
- 5. A lottery must not involve the use of any instrument or appliance for gaming declared by the Minister under section 2(4) of the Act.
- 6. Marina Bay Sands Pte. Ltd. must, before the start of the lotteries, undertake to ensure that an audited statement of accounts and the results of the lotteries are sent by registered post to the Head, Specialised Crime Policy Branch, Criminal Investigation Department, no later than 1 December 2015.
