# COMMON GAMING HOUSES (EXEMPTION) (NO. 35) NOTIFICATION 2012

#### ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Common Gaming Houses Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Notification:

### Citation

**1.** This Notification may be cited as the Common Gaming Houses (Exemption) (No. 35) Notification 2012.

## **Exemption**

- 2.—(1) The Minister hereby exempts Marina Bay Sands Pte. Ltd. from the provisions of the Act in respect of the "New Members' Scratch 2 Win" promotion to be held from 20th September 2012 to 31st December 2013 (both dates inclusive), within the integrated resort of Marina Bay Sands.
- (2) The exemption is subject to compliance by Marina Bay Sands Pte. Ltd. with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

#### THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 2

#### CONDITIONS

- 1. The methodology of the promotion, the details of the prizes to be distributed, their manner of distribution and, if the winners are determined solely or partly by a lottery, the time, date and place of the lottery, shall be disclosed in printed publicity material, copies of which shall be freely available to all participants.
- 2. Every lottery shall not involve the use of any game, method, device, scheme or competition declared by the Minister in a notification under section 2(3) of the Act.
- 3. Every lottery shall not involve the use of any instrument or appliance for gaming declared by the Minister in a notification under section 2(4) of the Act.
- 4. Marina Bay Sands Pte. Ltd. shall undertake to ensure that an audited statement of accounts shall, together with the results of the lotteries, be sent by registered post to the Head, Specialised Crime Policy Branch, Criminal Investigation Department, no later than 1st April 2014.
