# COMMON GAMING HOUSES ACT (CHAPTER 49)

## COMMON GAMING HOUSES (EXEMPTION) (NO. 56) NOTIFICATION 2015

#### ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

#### Paragraph

- 2. Exemption The Schedule

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Common Gaming Houses Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Notification:

#### Citation

1. This Notification may be cited as the Common Gaming Houses (Exemption) (No. 56) Notification 2015.

# Exemption

- **2.**—(1) The Minister exempts Clementi Active Ageing Committee (called the organiser) from the provisions of the Act in respect of
  - (a) the "Clementi Mahjong Challenge 2015" promotion to be held from 9 October 2015 to 15 November 2015 (both dates inclusive); and
  - (b) the mahigning games to be held at the multi-purpose hall of Clementi Community Centre from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. on 15 November 2015.
- (2) The exemption is subject to compliance by the organiser with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

### THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 2

#### **CONDITIONS**

- 1. The only game played must be mahjong.
- 2. All players must be citizens or permanent residents of Singapore, at least 50 years of age and residing in the Jurong Group Representation Constituency.
- 3. All spectators and staff must be at least 21 years of age.
- 4. Prize sponsors must not be involved in any business related to gambling.
- 5. Advertising for the mahjong competition must be confined to posters and banners displayed within the Jurong Group Representation Constituency.
- 6. The organiser may charge an entrance fee of \$5 to cover the cost of hosting the mahing competition, less the value of the prizes.
- 7. Token prizes can be allowed in recognition of the skills shown by the winners.
- 8. The organiser must ensure that the rules of the game are explained clearly to all players before the start of the event.
- 9. The organiser must deploy umpires on site to referee the event and resolve any disputes.
- 10. The mahjong activities must be held indoors at the multi-purpose hall of Clementi Community Centre.
- 11. The organiser must ensure that all doors to the multi-purpose hall of Clementi Community Centre are closed during the event so as to minimise noise from the event.
- 12. The organiser must open up the premises for spot-checks by the police during the event.
- 13. The organiser must take all reasonable steps to ensure that there are no private deals or side-betting throughout the event.
