# COMMON GAMING HOUSES (EXEMPTION) (NO. 63) NOTIFICATION 2014

#### ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Common Gaming Houses Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Notification:

### Citation

**1.** This Notification may be cited as the Common Gaming Houses (Exemption) (No. 63) Notification 2014.

## Exemption

**2.**—(1) The Minister hereby exempts the Singapore Turf Club from the provisions of the Act in respect of the "Sakura Day Lucky Draw" promotion to be held on 5 October 2014 between 11.30 a.m. and 6.50 p.m. and the draw to be held on 7 October 2014 at 10 a.m. at the Auditorium (Grandstand Level 2) of the Singapore Racecourse.

(2) The exemption is subject to compliance by the Singapore Turf Club with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

Paragraph 2

#### CONDITIONS

- 1. The methodology of the promotion, the details of the prizes to be distributed, their manner of distribution and, if the winners are determined solely or partly by a draw, the time, date and place of the draw, must be disclosed in printed publicity material, copies of which must be freely available to all participants.
- 2. The draw must be conducted by the Singapore Turf Club and its officers only.
- 3. The draw must not involve the use of any game, method, device, scheme or competition declared by the Minister in a notification under section 2(3) of the Act.
- 4. The draw must not involve the use of any instrument or appliance for gaming declared by the Minister in a notification under section 2(4) of the Act.
- 5. All winners must be notified by telephone or post.
- 6. The Singapore Turf Club must, before the start of the draw, undertake to ensure that an audited statement of accounts, together with the results of the draw, be sent by registered post to the Head, Specialised Crime Policy Branch, Criminal Investigation Department, no later than 8 January 2015.
