In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Common Gaming Houses Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Notification:

Citation

1. This Notification may be cited as the Common Gaming Houses (Exemption) (No. 61) Notification 2013.

Exemption

2.—(1) The Minister hereby exempts Tan Jun Ho (NRIC No. S8801803F) (referred to in this Notification as “the organiser”) from the provisions of the Act in respect of the “Sole Superior Singapore 2013” event to be held on 30th November 2013 from 1 p.m. to 6 p.m. and the draw to be held on 30th November 2013 at 6 p.m. at Zouk Singapore.

(2) The exemption is subject to compliance by the organiser with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 2

CONDITIONS

1. The methodology of the promotion, the details of the prizes to be distributed, their manner of distribution and, if the winners are determined solely or partly by a draw, the time, date and place of the draw, shall be disclosed in printed publicity material, copies of which shall be freely available to all participants.
2. Every draw shall be conducted by the organiser and his officers only.
3. Every draw shall be conducted in public.
4. Every draw shall not involve the use of any game, method, device, scheme or competition declared by the Minister in a notification under section 2(3) of the Act.
5. Every draw shall not involve the use of any instrument or appliance for gaming declared by the Minister in a notification under section 2(4) of the Act.
6. The organiser shall, before the start of any of the draws, undertake to ensure that —
 - (a) the results of the draws will be announced via the AV system at the draw area after each draw is completed; and
 - (b) an audited statement of accounts shall, together with the results of the draw, be sent by registered post to the Head, Specialised Crime Policy Branch, Criminal Investigation Department, no later than 1st March 2014.
