COMMON GAMING HOUSES (EXEMPTION) (NO. 80) NOTIFICATION 2014

ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Common Gaming Houses Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Notification:

Citation

1. This Notification may be cited as the Common Gaming Houses (Exemption) (No. 80) Notification 2014.

Exemption

2.—(1) The Minister hereby exempts Marina Bay Sands Pte. Ltd. from the provisions of the Act in respect of —

- (a) the "Fortune 6 Match2Win" promotion to be held from 28 November 2014 to 24 December 2014 (both dates inclusive); and
- (b) the "Fortune 6 Match2Win Scratch Card Game" to be held as part of that promotion at all Fortune Six No Commission Baccarat tables within the premises of the casino of Marina Bay Sands from 1 December 2014 to 24 December 2014 (both dates inclusive).

(2) The exemption is subject to compliance by Marina Bay Sands Pte. Ltd. with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 2

CONDITIONS

- 1. The methodology of the promotion, the details of the prizes to be distributed, their manner of distribution and, if the winners are determined solely or partly by a lottery, the time, date and place of the lottery, must be disclosed in printed publicity material, copies of which must be freely available to all participants.
- 2. The lottery must be conducted by persons in the employment of Marina Bay Sands Pte. Ltd. only.
- 3. The lottery must be conducted in public.
- 4. The lottery by means of a computerised system which is not conducted in public must be witnessed and audited by a public accountant who is not in the employment of Marina Bay Sands Pte. Ltd.
- 5. The lottery must not involve the use of any game, method, device, scheme or competition declared by the Minister in a notification under section 2(3) of the Act.
- 6. The lottery must not involve the use of any instrument or appliance for gaming declared by the Minister in a notification under section 2(4) of the Act.
- Marina Bay Sands Pte. Ltd. must, before the start of the lottery, undertake to ensure that an audited statement of accounts, together with the results of the lottery, be sent by registered post to the Head, Specialised Crime Policy Branch, Criminal Investigation Department, no later than 26 March 2015.
