COMMON GAMING HOUSES ACT (CHAPTER 49)

COMMON GAMING HOUSES (EXEMPTION) (NO. 81) NOTIFICATION 2014

ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

Paragraph

- 2. Exemption The Schedule

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Common Gaming Houses Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Notification:

Citation

1. This Notification may be cited as the Common Gaming Houses (Exemption) (No. 81) Notification 2014.

Exemption

- 2.—(1) The Minister hereby exempts Geylang West Community Club Women's Executive Committee (called the organiser) from the provisions of the Act in respect of
 - (a) the "Geylang West CC Mahjong Challenge 2014" promotion to be held from 30 November 2014 to 14 December 2014 (both dates inclusive); and
 - (b) the mahigning games to be held at the multi-purpose hall of Geylang West Community Club as part of that promotion from 9.30 a.m. to 4 p.m. on 14 December 2014.

(2) The exemption is subject to compliance by the organiser with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 2

CONDITIONS

- 1. The only game played must be mahjong.
- 2. All players must be at least 21 years of age and residing in such area within the Moulmein-Kallang Group Representation Constituency as is designated by the organiser to be the Jalan Besar district, and all spectators and staff must be at least 21 years of age.
- 3. Prize sponsors must not be involved in any business related to gambling.
- 4. Advertising for the mahjong competition must be confined to posters and banners displayed within the Jalan Besar district.
- 5. The organiser may charge an entrance fee of \$25 to cover the cost of hosting the mahing competition, less the value of the prizes.
- 6. Token prizes can be allowed in recognition of the skills shown by the winners.
- 7. The organiser must ensure that the rules of the game are explained clearly to all players before the start of the event.
- 8. The organiser must deploy umpires on site to referee the event and resolve any disputes.
- 9. The mahjong activities must be held indoors at the multi-purpose hall of Geylang West Community Club.
- 10. The multi-purpose hall of Geylang West Community Club must have adequate sound-proofing to minimise noise pollution.
- 11. The organiser must open up the premises for spot-checks by the police during the event.
- 12. The organiser must take all reasonable steps to ensure that there are no private deals or side-betting throughout the event.
