COMMON GAMING HOUSES (TABERNACLE OF CHRIST — EXEMPTION) NOTIFICATION 2019

ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Common Gaming Houses Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Notification:

Citation

1. This Notification is the Common Gaming Houses (Tabernacle of Christ — Exemption) Notification 2019.

Exemption

2.—(1) The Minister exempts Tabernacle of Christ (UEN S94SS0110C) (called in this Notification the organiser) from the provisions of the Act in respect of —

- (a) the "Christmas Charity Carnival" (called in this Notification the event) to be held from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. on 7 December 2019 at 3 Yishun Street 11 #02-00, Singapore 768645; and
- (b) the draws for the lottery to be held at 12 noon and 3 p.m. on7 December 2019 at the venue of the event.

(2) The exemption is subject to compliance by the organiser with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 2

CONDITIONS

- 1. The organiser may only allow individuals attending the event to participate in the lottery to be conducted by the organiser during the event.
- 2. Each lottery ticket must only be issued by way of sale and upon receipt of its price in full.
- 3. All the following details must be included in printed publicity material that must be freely accessible to every participant of the lottery:
 - (a) the name and address of the organiser;
 - (b) the details of the prizes to be distributed;
 - (c) the time, date and place of the draws.
- 4. The lottery must not involve the use of any game, method, device, scheme or competition declared by the Minister under section 2(3) of the Act to be a lottery or a game of chance or of mixed chance and skill.
- 5. The lottery must not involve the use of any article declared by the Minister under section 2(4) of the Act to be an instrument or appliance for gaming.
- 6. The organiser must, before the start of the lottery, undertake to ensure that an audited statement of accounts and the results of the lottery are sent by registered post to the Head, Specialised Crime Policy Branch, Criminal Investigation Department, no later than 8 March 2020.
