In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Common Gaming Houses Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Notification:

**Citation**

1. This Notification may be cited as the Common Gaming Houses (Exemption) (No. 10) Notification 2015.

**Exemption**

2.—(1) The Minister hereby exempts the Grand Mercure Roxy Singapore (called the organiser) from the provisions of the Act in respect of the “Scratch for Charity & Win” promotion to be held from 1 March 2015 to 31 August 2015 (both dates inclusive).

(2) The exemption is subject to compliance by the organiser with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

## THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 2(2)

### CONDITIONS

1. The price of each scratch & win card, the name and address of the organiser, and the details of the prizes to be distributed must be clearly stated on the card.
2. The organiser may only issue a scratch & win card by way of sale and upon receipt of the price of the card in full.
3. Every participant of the lottery must be at least 18 years of age.
4. The organiser must, before the start of the lottery, undertake to ensure that an audited statement of accounts and the results of the lottery are sent by registered post to the Head, Specialised Crime Policy Branch, Criminal Investigation Department, no later than 1 December 2015.
