PRIME MINISTER'S OFFICE)  
NOTIFICATION 2015

**Responsibility of Minister, Prime Minister's Office**

It is notified for general information that, pursuant to Article 30(1) of the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore, the Prime Minister has directed that, with effect from 9 April 2015, Mr Chan Chun Sing is charged with the responsibility for —

- (a) advising the Prime Minister on matters relating to the maintenance of industrial peace, the productivity of Singapore's workforce, and the well-being and welfare of workers; and
- (b) discharging such other duties as the Prime Minister may assign,

and designated as the Minister, Prime Minister's Office.

**Citation**

2. This Notification may be cited as the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore (Responsibility of the Minister, Prime Minister's Office) Notification 2015.

**Cancellation**

3. The Constitution of the Republic of Singapore (Responsibility of the Minister, Prime Minister's Office) Notification 2011 (G.N. No. S 296/2011) is cancelled, with effect from 4 May 2015.
