In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Third Schedule to the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Notification:

#### **Citation and commencement**

1. This Notification may be cited as the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore (Delegation of Powers) Notification 2004 and shall come into operation on 1st August 2004.

#### **Delegation of powers**

2. The Minister for Home Affairs hereby delegates to the Registrar of Citizens, the Deputy Registrar of Citizens and Assistant Registrars of Citizens, the functions of the Minister under Articles 123 and 124 of the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore.

#### **Cancellation**

3. The Delegation of Powers (Ministry of Home Affairs) Notification 1990 (G.N. No. S 278/90) is cancelled.
