#### CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF SINGAPORE (RESPONSIBILITY OF THE DEPUTY PRIME MINISTER AND COORDINATING MINISTER FOR NATIONAL SECURITY) NOTIFICATION 2015

### **Responsibility of Deputy Prime Minister and Coordinating Minister for National Security**

It is notified for general information that the Prime Minister has, under Article 30(1) of the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore, directed that with effect from 1 October 2015, Mr Teo Chee Hean is —

- (a) charged with the responsibility for —
  - (i) strategic planning, collaboration and coordination between Ministries and statutory bodies in their policies and enforcement action to address internal or external threats to Singapore’s national security; and
  - (ii) the portfolio of the Prime Minister insofar as it relates to the departments and subjects set out in the Schedule; and
- (b) designated as the Deputy Prime Minister and Coordinating Minister for National Security, Prime Minister’s Office.

### **Citation**

2. This Notification may be cited as the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore (Responsibility of the Deputy Prime Minister and Coordinating Minister for National Security) Notification 2015.
