Responsibility of Minister for Health

It is notified for general information that the Prime Minister has, under Article 30(1) of the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore, directed that with effect from 1 October 2015, Mr Gan Kim Yong is charged with the responsibility for the departments and subjects set out in the Schedule and designated as the Minister for Health.
