In exercise of the powers conferred by section 27 of the COVID-19 (Temporary Measures) Act 2020, the Minister for Law makes the following Order:

## **Citation and commencement**

**1.** This Order is the COVID-19 (Temporary Measures) (Alternative Arrangements for Meetings for Schools) Order 2020 and is deemed to have come into operation on 27 March 2020.

## Definitions

2. In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires —

"committee of management" and "manager" have the meanings given by section 2 of the Education Act (Cap. 87);

"electronic means" means electronic communication, video conferencing, tele-conferencing or other electronic means;

"governing board" means the governing board constituted by the School Boards (Raffles Girls' School — Secondary) Order (Cap. 284A, O 2);

"governor" has the meaning given by section 2 of the School Boards (Incorporation) Act (Cap. 284A);

- (a) a meeting of a committee of management; or
- (b) a meeting of the governing board;

"school" means any school —

- (a) to which the Education Act applies; and
- (b) that is administered by a committee of management.

## **Control measures**

- **3.** This Order is made in respect of the following control measures:
  - (a) the COVID-19 (Temporary Measures) (Control Order) Regulations 2020 (G.N. No. S 254/2020);
  - (*b*) the Infectious Diseases (Measures to Prevent Spread of COVID-19) Regulations 2020 (G.N. No. S 185/2020).

## Application

**4.** This Order sets out the alternative arrangements to personal attendance in respect of the following classes of meetings:

- (a) meetings of committees of management;
- (b) meetings of the governing board.

# Alternative arrangements for meetings of committees of management

**5.**—(1) The alternative arrangements for the convening, holding, conducting or deferral of a meeting of a committee of management set out in the second column of the First Schedule apply in respect of the provisions of the written law or legal instrument relating to such a meeting set out in the first column of that Schedule.

(2) The alternative arrangements apply for the period starting on 27 March 2020 and ending on 30 September 2020.

## Alternative arrangements for meetings of governing board

**6.**—(1) The alternative arrangements for the convening, holding, conducting or deferral of a meeting of the governing board set out in the second column of the Second Schedule apply in respect of the provisions of the written law relating to such a meeting set out in the first column of that Schedule.

(2) The alternative arrangements apply for the period starting on 27 March 2020 and ending on 30 September 2020.

## ALTERNATIVE ARRANGEMENTS FOR MEETINGS OF COMMITTEES OF MANAGEMENT

First column

Provision of Education Act or constitution, written scheme or deed of trust in accordance with which the school is managed

- 1. Provision for convening, holding, conducting or deferral of a meeting of a committee of management
- 2. Provision for attendance at a meeting of a committee of management
- 3. Provision for quorum at a meeting of a committee of management

Second column

Alternative arrangement

A meeting of a committee of management may be convened, held or conducted, whether wholly or partly, by electronic means.

A meeting of a committee of management may be deferred to a date no later than 30 September 2020.

A manager of a school may attend a meeting by electronic means.

A quorum may be formed by managers of a school personally or electronically present and satisfying the relevant quorum requirements.

#### FIRST SCHEDULE — continued

First column

Provision of Education Act or constitution, written scheme or deed of trust in accordance with which the school is managed

4. Provision for a manager of a school to vote at a meeting of a committee of management

5. Provision for laying and production of documents at a meeting of a committee of management

6. Provision for giving of notice of a meeting of a committee of management Second column

Alternative arrangement

A manager of a school is electronically present at a meeting if the manager —

- (*a*) attends the meeting in the manner provided in item 2;
- (b) is verified by the secretary of the committee of management or a person appointed by the committee of management to verify the quorum as attending the meeting in the manner provided in item 2; and
- (c) is acknowledged by electronic means by the chairman of the meeting as present at the meeting.

A manager of a school may vote at the meeting by electronic means.

A document required to be laid or produced before a meeting of a committee of management may be so laid or produced by being sent with the notice of the meeting.

A notice of a meeting may be sent by electronic means and —

 (a) must describe the means by which the meeting can be electronically accessed (including the online location, if the meeting is held at an online location);

Alternative arrangement

- (b) must set out how a manager of a school may vote at the meeting by electronic means; and
- (c) may be accompanied by any other documents relevant to the meeting.

For the purposes of this item, a notice is sent by electronic means only if the notice is sent by the secretary of the committee of management by electronic mail —

- (a) to all managers of a school; and
- (b) to the electronic mail address of each manager notified by the manager to the committee of management.

#### ALTERNATIVE ARRANGEMENTS FOR MEETINGS OF GOVERNING BOARD

First column

Second column Alternative arrangement

Provision of School Boards (Raffles Girls' School — Secondary) Order

- 1. Provision for convening, holding, conducting or deferral of a meeting of the governing board
- 2. Provision for attendance at a meeting of a meeting of the governing board
- 3. Provision for quorum at a meeting of the governing board

A meeting of the governing board may be convened, held or conducted, whether wholly or partly, by electronic means.

A meeting of the governing board may be deferred to a date no later than 30 September 2020.

A governor may attend a meeting by electronic means.

A quorum may be formed by governors personally or electronically present and satisfying the relevant quorum requirements.

A governor is electronically present at a meeting if the governor —

- (*a*) attends the meeting in the manner provided in item 2;
- (b) is verified by the secretary of the governing board or a person appointed by the governing board to verify the quorum as attending the meeting in the manner provided in item 2; and
- (c) is acknowledged by electronic means by the chairman of the meeting as present at the meeting.

Provision of School Boards (Raffles Girls' School — Secondary) Order

- 4. Provision for a governor to vote at a meeting of the governing board
- 5. Provision for laying and production of documents at a meeting of the governing board
- 6. Provision for giving of notice of a meeting of the governing board

Second column

Alternative arrangement

A governor may vote at the meeting by electronic means.

A document required to be laid or produced before a meeting of the governing board may be so laid or produced by being sent with the notice of the meeting.

A notice of a meeting may be sent by electronic means and —

- (a) must describe the means by which the meeting can be electronically accessed (including the online location, if the meeting is held at an online location);
- (b) must set out how a governor may vote at the meeting by electronic means; and
- (c) may be accompanied by any other documents relevant to the meeting.

For the purposes of this item, a notice is sent by electronic means only if the notice is sent by the secretary of the governing board by electronic mail —

- (a) to all governors; and
- (b) to the electronic mail address of each governor notified by the governor to the governing board.
