# COVID-19 (TEMPORARY MEASURES) (ALTERNATIVE ARRANGEMENTS FOR MEETINGS FOR SPECIFIED PUBLIC BODIES AND GOVERNING BODIES) ORDER 2020

#### ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 27 of the COVID-19 (Temporary Measures) Act 2020, the Minister for Law makes the following Order:

## **Citation and commencement**

**1.** This Order is the COVID-19 (Temporary Measures) (Alternative Arrangements for Meetings for Specified Public Bodies and Governing Bodies) Order 2020 and is deemed to have come into operation on 27 March 2020.

# Definitions

2. In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires —

"constitutional Act", in relation to a public body, means the Act by or under which the public body is established;

- "electronic means" means electronic communication, video conferencing, tele-conferencing or other electronic means;
- "governing body" means the governing body of a specified public body, where the constitutional Act of the specified public body provides for such a governing body;

- (a) a meeting of a specified public body; or
- (b) a meeting of a governing body;

"member" —

- (a) in relation to a meeting of a specified public body, means a member of a specified public body; or
- (b) in relation to a meeting of a governing body, means a member of a governing body;
- "public body" means a body established by a public Act, but excludes a Town Council established under section 4 of the Town Councils Act (Cap. 329A);
- "specified public body" means a public body specified in the First Schedule.

#### **Control measures**

- **3.** This Order is made in respect of the following control measures:
  - (*a*) the COVID-19 (Temporary Measures) (Control Order) Regulations 2020 (G.N. No. S 254/2020);
  - (*b*) the Infectious Diseases (Measures to Prevent Spread of COVID-19) Regulations 2020 (G.N. No. S 185/2020).

#### Application

**4.** This Order sets out the alternative arrangements to personal attendance in respect of the following classes of meetings:

- (a) meetings of specified public bodies;
- (b) meetings of governing bodies.

## Alternative arrangements for meetings of specified public bodies and meetings of governing bodies

**5.**—(1) The alternative arrangements for the convening, holding, conducting or deferral of a meeting of a specified public body or a meeting of a governing body set out in the second column of the Second Schedule apply in respect of the provisions of the written law or legal instrument relating to such a meeting set out in the first column of that Schedule.

(2) The alternative arrangements apply for the period starting on 27 March 2020 and ending on 30 September 2020.

#### ALTERNATIVE ARRANGEMENTS FOR MEETINGS OF SPECIFIED PUBLIC BODIES AND GOVERNING BODIES

A meeting may be convened, held or conducted, whether wholly or partly, by electronic means if the following are satisfied:

(a) all members who wish to participate at a meeting have

	access to the technology needed to participate in the meeting;
	(b) a quorum of members can simultaneously communicate with each other throughout the meeting.
	A meeting may be deferred to a date no later than 30 September 2020.
2. Provision for attendance at a meeting	A member may attend a meeting by electronic means.
3. Provision for quorum at a meeting	A quorum may be formed by members personally or electronically present and satisfying the relevant quorum requirements.
	A member is electronically present at a meeting if the member attends the meeting in the manner provided in item 2.
4. Provision for a member to vote at a meeting	A member may vote at the meeting by electronic means.
5. Provision for laying and production of documents at a meeting	A document required to be laid or produced before a meeting may be so laid or produced by being sent with the notice of the meeting.
6. Provision for giving of notice of a meeting	A notice of a meeting may be sent by electronic means and —
	<ul> <li>(a) must describe the means by which the meeting can be electronically accessed (including the online location, if the meeting is held at an online location);</li> </ul>

- (b) must set out how a member may vote at the meeting by electronic means; and
- (c) may be accompanied by any other documents relevant to the meeting.

For the purposes of this item, a notice is sent by electronic means only if —

- (a) in the case of a meeting of a specified public body, the notice is sent by electronic mail
  - (i) to all members of the specified public body; and
  - (ii) to the electronic mail address of each member of the specified public body notified by the member to the specified public body; and
- (b) in the case of a meeting of a governing body, the notice is sent by electronic mail —
  - (i) to all members of the governing body; and
  - (ii) to the electronic mail address of each member of the governing body notified by the member to the governing body.
