In exercise of the powers conferred by section 111 of the Environmental Public Health Act 1987, the National Environment Agency, with the approval of the Minister for Sustainability and the Environment, makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations are the Environmental Public Health (Fees for Controlled Works Applications) Regulations 2025 and come into operation on 1 April 2025.

Application fees

2. The fees specified in the second column of the Schedule are payable to the National Environment Agency for the applications specified opposite in the first column of that Schedule.

Refund of fees

3.—(1) An applicant is not entitled to a refund of any application fee paid.

(2) Despite paragraph (1), the Director-General may refund, in whole or in part, any fee paid under these Regulations in a particular case.
