In exercise of the powers conferred by the definition of “registrable aerosol-generating system” in section 2 of the Environmental Public Health Act, the National Environment Agency, with the approval of the Minister for Sustainability and the Environment, makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order is the Environmental Public Health (Registrable Aerosol-generating Systems) Order 2021 and comes into operation on 31 August 2021.

Definition

2. In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires, “cooling tower” means any aerosol-generating system in which atmospheric air is passed through sprayed water in order to lower the temperature of the water by evaporative cooling.

Registrable aerosol-generating system

3. Every aerosol-generating system that is a cooling tower is a registrable aerosol-generating system for the purposes of the Act.
