ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 of the Foreign National Emblems (Control of Display) Act 1949, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Order:

Citation

1. This Order is the Foreign National Emblems (Control of Display) (Visit of Prince of Wales from 5 to 8 November 2023 — Exemption) Order 2023.

Exemption

2.—(1) Section 3 of the Act does not apply to the display of a relevant foreign national emblem —

- (a) at any time during the period from 5 November 2023 to 8 November 2023 (both dates inclusive); and
- (b) at any venue where the Prince of Wales is attending an event or meeting members of the public.

(2) For the purposes of sub-paragraph (1), the following are relevant foreign national emblems:

- (a) the flag of the United Kingdom;
- (b) the Royal Standard of the United Kingdom;
- (c) the flag of England;
- (d) the flag of Scotland;
- (e) the flag of Wales.
