#### ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

### Paragraph

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 36(1) of the Interpretation Act, the Minister for Law, with the approval of the President, hereby makes the following Notification:

#### Citation and commencement

1. This Notification may be cited as the Interpretation (Delegation of Powers — Ministry of Law) (No. 2) Notification 2011 and shall come into operation on 1st September 2011.

## **Delegation of powers**

- **2.** The Minister for Law hereby deputes the Senior Parliamentary Secretary, Ministry of Law, to exercise the powers of the Minister under
  - (a) section 151A of the Copyright Act (Cap. 63);
  - (b) sections 249, 252, 253, 255 and 256 of the Criminal Procedure Code 2010 (Act 15 of 2010);
  - (c) section 26 of the Land Acquisition Act (Cap. 152);

- (d) section 4 of the Land Surveyors Act (Cap. 156); and
- (e) section 20(5) of the Pawnbrokers Act (Cap. 222).

**3.** Item 1 in the Schedule to the Delegation of Powers (Ministry of Law) (Consolidation) Notification (N 10) is deleted.
