In exercise of the powers conferred by section 46(2) of the Interpretation Act, the Minister for Transport hereby makes the following Order:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Interpretation (Temporary Suspension of Electronic Road Pricing System Charges) Order 2014.

Temporary suspension of charges

- 2.—(1) For the period 17 September 2014 to 19 September 2014 (both dates inclusive), the road-user charges payable under the First Schedule to the Road Traffic (Electronic Road Pricing System) Rules 2011 (G.N. No. S 97/2011) (referred to as the principal Rules) in respect of any motor vehicle ridden, driven or moved into a specified entry point on a specified road set out in Part 1 of the Schedule shall be wholly remitted during the restricted hours as specified opposite in the second column.
- (2) For the period 17 September 2014 to 20 September 2014 (both dates inclusive), the road-user charges payable under the First

Schedule to the principal Rules in respect of any motor vehicle ridden, driven or moved into a specified entry point on a specified road set out in Part 2 of the Schedule shall be wholly remitted during the restricted hours as specified opposite in the second column.

- (3) On 18 September 2014 and 19 September 2014, the road-user charges payable under the First Schedule to the principal Rules in respect of any motor vehicle ridden, driven or moved into a specified entry point on a specified road set out in Part 3 of the Schedule shall be wholly remitted during the restricted hours as specified opposite in the second column.
- (4) For the period 18 September 2014 to 20 September 2014 (both dates inclusive), the road-user charges payable under the First Schedule to the principal Rules in respect of any motor vehicle ridden, driven or moved into a specified entry point on a specified road set out in Part 4 of the Schedule shall be wholly remitted during the restricted hours as specified opposite in the second column.
