INTERPRETATION (CUSTOMS DECLARATION — FEES) ORDER 2012

ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 46 of the Interpretation Act, the Minister for Finance hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Interpretation (Customs Declaration — Fees) Order 2012 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 30th October 2007.

Fees for customs declaration

2. *There shall be payable to the Director-General of Customs the following fees for every declaration required by the Customs Act (Cap. 70) for the import, export or transshipment of goods:*

- (a) *\$0.90 per declaration made before 19th December 2012 by electronic notice through TradeNet solely for the purposes of that Act;*
- (b) *\$10 per declaration made not using TradeNet before 19th December 2012 solely for the purposes of that Act.*

Remission

3. The Director-General of Customs may, in any particular case, remit wholly or in part any fee payable under paragraph 2.
