Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Legitimacy (Reregistration of Births of Legitimated Persons) Regulations.

Manner of re-registration

- **2.**—(1) The re-registration of the birth of a legitimated person shall be effected at the office of the Registrar-General of Births and Deaths and upon production of the following documents:
 - (a) the birth certificate of the legitimated person;
 - (b) the marriage certificate of the parents of the legitimated person;
 - (c) a statutory declaration by each parent acknowledging himself or herself to be the natural parent of the legitimated person or a certified true copy of a declaration of the legitimacy of the legitimated person made by the court under section 4 of the Act; and

(d) such other documents as may be required by the Registrar-General of Births and Deaths.

(2) Where the paternity of a legitimated person has been established by an affiliation order or otherwise by a decree of a court of competent jurisdiction, a certified true copy of that order or decree may be produced in lieu of a statutory declaration of paternity by the father of the legitimated person under paragraph (1)(c) for the purposes of reregistration of the birth of the legitimated person.

Fee

3. For the purposes of paragraph 5 of the Schedule to the Act, the fee for re-registration of the birth of a legitimated person where the necessary information for the purpose is not furnished within the time specified in that Schedule shall be \$2.
