# MEDICINES (ADVERTISEMENT AND SALE) (EXEMPTION) ORDER 2004

#### ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

## Paragraph

- 1. Citation and commencement
- 2. Exemption from sections 4 and 5 of Act

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 9 of the Medicines (Advertisement and Sale) Act, Mr Khaw Boon Wan, Senior Minister of State, Ministry of Finance, charged with the responsibility of the Minister for Health, hereby makes the following Order:

### Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Medicines (Advertisement and Sale) (Exemption) Order 2004 and shall come into operation on 17th May 2004.

# Exemption from sections 4 and 5 of Act

- **2.** Sections 4 and 5 of the Act do not apply in relation to an advertisement published by
  - (a) a person who is licensed under the Healthcare Services Act 2020 to provide any licensable healthcare service; or
  - (b) a person who holds a licence for a healthcare institution under the Private Hospitals and Medical Clinics Act 1980.
