In exercise of the powers conferred by section 5(4) of the Parliamentary Elections Act 1954, the Prime Minister makes the following Order:

Citation

1. This Order is the Parliamentary Elections (Prescribed Date) Order 2025.

Prescribed date

2. For the purposes of section 5(1), (1A) and (2) of the Act, the prescribed date is 1 February in any year instead of 1 July.

Revocation

3. Revoke the Parliamentary Elections (Prescribed Date) Order 2023 (G.N. No. S 324/2023).
