# PRIVATE SECURITY INDUSTRY (COMPOSITION OF OFFENCES) REGULATIONS 2009

#### ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

### Regulation

- 1. Citation and commencement
- 2. Compoundable offences
- 3. Revocation

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 39 of the Private Security Industry Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Regulations:

### Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Private Security Industry (Composition of Offences) Regulations 2009 and shall come into operation on 27th April 2009.

## Compoundable offences

- **2.** The following offences may be compounded by the licensing officer in accordance with section 33(1) of the Act:
  - (a) an offence under section 8(4), 9(3) (in relation to the contravention of section 9(1)), 16(4), 17(3) (in relation to the contravention of section 17(1)) or 22(5) of the Act;
  - (b) an offence under regulation 26(2) or 27 of the Private Security Industry (Private Investigation and Security Agencies) Regulations 2009 (G.N. No. S 167/2009);

- (c) an offence under regulation 14(2) or 15 of the Private Security Industry (Security Service Providers) Regulations 2009 (G.N. No. S 168/2009); and
- (d) an offence under regulation 8(1) or (2) of the Private Security Industry (Conduct) Regulations 2009 (G.N. No. S 170/2009).

### Revocation

**3.** The Private Investigation and Security Agencies (Composition of Offences) Regulations 2005 (G.N. No. S 658/2005) are revoked.
