REMOTE GAMBLING (NATIONAL HERITAGE BOARD — EXEMPTION) (NO. 2) ORDER 2022

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 40 of the Remote Gambling Act 2014, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Order:

Citation

1. This Order is the Remote Gambling (National Heritage Board — Exemption) (No. 2) Order 2022.

Definitions

2. In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires —

“draw” means any draw to be held as part of the promotion at 61 Stamford Road, #03-08 Stamford Court, Singapore 178892 at the following times:

- (a) 3 p.m. on 12 July 2022;
- (b) 3 p.m. on 18 July 2022;
- (c) 3 p.m. and 3.15 p.m. on 25 July 2022;

“organiser” means the National Heritage Board established by section 3 of the National Heritage Board Act 1993;

“promotion” means the promotion called “Heritage Hunter: The Way Home” that is to be made available from 5 July 2022 to 24 July 2022 (both dates inclusive) on the website at <https://www.roots.gov.sg>;

“public accountant” has the meaning given by section 2(1) of the Accountants Act 2004.

Exemptions

3.—(1) The organiser is exempt from sections 11, 13, 15 and 17 of the Act in respect of the promotion and the draws.

(2) The organiser is exempt from sections 13, 15 and 17 of the Act from 30 June 2022 to 4 July 2022 (both dates inclusive) in respect of any prohibited act under any of those sections carried out for the purposes of the promotion and the draws.

(3) The exemptions are subject to compliance by the organiser with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 3(3)

CONDITIONS

1. All the following details must be included in publicity material that must be freely accessible to every participant of a draw:
 - (a) the name and address of the organiser;
 - (b) the details of the prizes to be distributed;
 - (c) the manner in which the prizes will be distributed;
 - (d) the time, date and place of the draw;
 - (e) how a person may participate in the draw;
 - (f) the manner in which the draw is to be conducted.
2. The organiser must keep a record of the name, contact number and email address of every participant of a draw.
3. Only persons in the employment of the organiser may conduct a draw.

THE SCHEDULE — *continued*

4. Each draw must —
 - (a) be conducted in a manner where members of the public or a section of the public may witness the draw; or
 - (b) if conducted in private by means of a computerised system, be witnessed and audited by a public accountant who is not in the employment of the organiser.
5. The organiser must undertake to ensure that every winner is notified by telephone and email.
6. The organiser must, before the start of the draws, undertake to ensure that an audited statement of accounts and the results of the draws are sent by registered post to the Head, Specialised Crime Policy Branch, Criminal Investigation Department, Singapore Police Force, no later than 26 October 2022.
