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In exercise of the powers conferred by section 40 of the Remote Gambling Act 2014, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Order:

**Citation**

1. This Order is the Remote Gambling (Exemption) (No. 8) Order 2018.

**Definitions**

2. In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires —

“draw” means any draw to be held as part of the promotion at 3 Second Hospital Avenue, Singapore 168937 between 3 p.m. and 5 p.m. on the following dates:

- (a) 18 January 2019;
- (b) 15 February 2019;
- (c) 15 March 2019;

(d) 12 April 2019;

“organiser” means the Health Promotion Board established by section 3 of the Health Promotion Board Act (Cap. 122B);

“promotion” means the promotion called “National Step Challenge<sup>TM</sup> Season 4 — Community Challenge Monthly Lucky Draws” that is to be made available from 1 December 2018 to 31 March 2019 (both dates inclusive) on the Healthy 365 mobile application platform maintained by the organiser;

“public accountant” has the meaning given by section 2(1) of the Accountants Act (Cap. 2).

### **Exemption**

3.—(1) The organiser is exempt from sections 11, 13, 15 and 17 of the Act in respect of the promotion and the draws.

(2) The exemption is subject to compliance by the organiser with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

## THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 3(2)

### CONDITIONS

1. All the following details must be included in publicity material that must be freely accessible to every participant of a draw:
  - (a) the name and address of the organiser;
  - (b) the details of the prizes to be distributed;
  - (c) the manner in which the prizes will be distributed;
  - (d) the time, date and place of the draw;
  - (e) how a person may participate in the draw;
  - (f) the manner in which the draw is to be conducted.
2. The organiser must keep a record of the name, email address and telephone number of every participant of a draw.
3. Only persons in the employment of the organiser may conduct a draw.

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THE SCHEDULE — *continued*

4. Each draw must —
- (a) be conducted in public; or
  - (b) if conducted in private by means of a computerised system, be witnessed and audited by a public accountant who is not in the employment of the organiser.
5. The organiser must undertake to ensure that —
- (a) every winner is notified by telephone; and
  - (b) the results of each draw are published —
    - (i) on the website at <https://www.healthhub.sg/programmes/124/community-challenge>; and
    - (ii) in an English local daily newspaper.
6. The organiser must, before the start of the draws, undertake to ensure that an audited statement of accounts and the results of the draws are sent by registered post to the Head, Specialised Crime Policy Branch, Criminal Investigation Department, Singapore Police Force, no later than 13 July 2019.
