In exercise of the powers conferred by section 40 of the Remote Gambling Act 2014, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Order:

Citation

1. This Order is the Remote Gambling (Info-communications Media Development Authority — Exemption) Order 2020.

Definitions

2. In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires —

“draw” means any draw to be held as part of the promotion at 298 Tiong Bahru Road, #06-01, Singapore 168730 at 10 a.m. on the following dates:

- (a) 22 December 2020;
- (b) 26 January 2021;
- (c) 24 February 2021;

(d) 23 March 2021;

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(e) 27 April 2021;

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(f) 31 May 2021;

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“organiser” means the Info-communications Media Development Authority established by section 3 of the Info-communications Media Development Authority Act 2016 (Act 22 of 2016);

“promotion” means the promotion called “Hawkers Go Digital (HGD) Lucky Draw” that is to be made available from 30 October 2020 to 30 April 2021 (both dates inclusive) —

(a) on the website at <https://www.sdo.gov.sg/programmes/scan-pay-win>;

(b) on the Facebook, Instagram and YouTube social media platforms maintained by the organiser and SG Digital Office; and

(c) on any other medium or platform approved by the organiser;

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“public accountant” has the meaning given by section 2(1) of the Accountants Act (Cap. 2).

Exemption

3.—(1) The organiser is exempt from sections 11, 13, 15 and 17 of the Act in respect of the promotion and the draws.

(2) The exemption is subject to compliance by the organiser with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 3(2)

CONDITIONS

1. All the following details must be included in publicity material that must be freely accessible to every participant of a draw:
 - (a) the name and address of the organiser;
 - (b) the details of the prizes to be distributed;
 - (c) the manner in which the prizes will be distributed;
 - (d) the time, date and place of the draw;
 - (e) how a person may participate in the draw;
 - (f) the manner in which the draw is to be conducted.
2. The organiser must keep a record of the name and contact number of every participant of a draw.
3. Only persons in the employment of the organiser may conduct a draw.
4. Each draw, when conducted in private by means of a computerised system, must be witnessed and audited by a public accountant who is not in the employment of the organiser.
5. The organiser must undertake to ensure that —
 - (a) every winner is notified by email, telephone or post; and
 - (b) the results of each draw are published on the website at <https://www.sdo.gov.sg/programmes/scan-pay-win>.
6. The organiser must, before the start of the draws, undertake to ensure that an audited statement of accounts and the results of the draws are sent by registered post to the Head, Specialised Crime Policy Branch, Criminal Investigation Department, Singapore Police Force, no later than 1 September 2021.
