- (2) This Order is in force for the period between 22 March 2022 and 28 February 2023 (both dates inclusive).

Definitions

2. In this Order, "specified road", "trial", and "trial power-assisted bicycle" have the meanings given by paragraph 2 of the Road Traffic (Coast Cycles Pte. Ltd. — Exemption) Order 2022 (G.N. No. S 97/2022).

Exemption for use of trial power-assisted bicycle

3. Part 2 of the Act does not apply to a person who uses, or causes or permits any other person to use, a trial power-assisted bicycle on a specified road during and in connection with the trial under the

conditions mentioned in paragraph 3 of the Road Traffic (Coast Cycles Pte. Ltd. — Exemption) Order 2022.
