ROAD TRAFFIC (VOCATIONAL LICENCE FOR BUS CONDUCTORS AND DRIVERS — EXEMPTION) ORDER 2017

ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

Paragraph

- 3. Exemption of bus drivers

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 142 of the Road Traffic Act, the Minister for Transport makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order is the Road Traffic (Vocational Licence for Bus Conductors and Drivers — Exemption) Order 2017 and comes into operation on 20 June 2017.

Exemption of bus conductors

- **2.**—(1) Section 110(1)(*a*) of the Act does not apply to, or in relation to, any person acting as a conductor of the Malaysia inter-state express bus service known as Bas Ekspres when holding a licence under the laws of Malaysia that is equivalent to a vocational licence granted under Part V of the Act to act as a bus conductor.
- (2) Section 110(1)(b) of the Act does not apply to an employer of any conductor mentioned in sub-paragraph (1).

Exemption of bus drivers

- **3.**—(1) Section 110(1)(a) of the Act does not apply to any of the following:
 - (a) a person who drives a private bus;
 - (b) a person who is an employee of the owner or hirer of any of the following buses which has the approval of the Registrar for use as a private bus for a specified group of passengers and period, when driving the bus in the course of that employment and in accordance with that approval:
 - (i) a private hire bus;
 - (ii) an excursion bus;
 - (c) any person who drives the Malaysia inter-state express bus service known as Bas Ekspres when holding a licence under the laws of Malaysia that is equivalent to a vocational licence granted under Part V of the Act to act as a bus driver;

- (d) any person who drives a bus that
 - (i) is registered under the laws of Malaysia;
 - (ii) is the subject of an omnibus licence granted under Part V of the Act; and
 - (iii) is being used to provide a passenger transport service for journeys between Johor and Singapore,

when holding a licence under the laws of Malaysia that is equivalent to a vocational licence granted under Part V of the Act to act as an omnibus driver.

- (2) Section 110(1)(b) of the Act does not apply to an employer of a person exempt under any of the sub-paragraphs of sub-paragraph (1).
- (3) For the purpose of sub-paragraph (1)(d), "omnibus licence" has the same meaning as in the Road Traffic (Public Service Vehicles) Rules (R 14).
