# ROAD TRAFFIC (MOTOR VEHICLES, CONSTRUCTION AND USE) (EXEMPTION FOR 3-DOOR OMNIBUS) ORDER 2019

#### ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 142 of the Road Traffic Act, the Minister for Transport makes the following Order:

### **Citation and commencement**

**1.** This Order is the Road Traffic (Motor Vehicles, Construction and Use) (Exemption for 3-door Omnibus) Order 2019 and comes into operation on 24 April 2019.

# Definition

**2.** In this Order, "3-door omnibus" means an omnibus that has 3 sets of entrance and exit doors for passengers to board and disembark.

### Exemption

**3.**—(1) Subject to sub-paragraph (2), rules 6(1), 44(1), 60(1) and 77(1)(d) of the Road Traffic (Motor Vehicles, Construction and Use) Rules (R 9) do not apply to a 3-door omnibus that is owned by the Authority.

(2) The exemption in sub-paragraph (1) is subject to the condition that there must be in force, at all times, a policy of insurance in relation to the 3-door omnibus insuring against any liability in respect of —

- (*a*) damage to any property caused by or arising out of the use of that 3-door omnibus; and
- (b) the death of, or bodily injury sustained by, any person caused by or arising out of the use of that 3-door omnibus.
