### ROAD TRAFFIC (FEES FOR VEHICLE RECALLS) RULES 2012

#### ARRANGEMENT OF RULES

##### Rule

1. Citation and commencement
  2. Fees

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 140 of the Road Traffic Act, the Minister for Transport hereby makes the following Rules:

#### **Citation and commencement**

1. These Rules may be cited as the Road Traffic (Fees for Vehicle Recalls) Rules 2012 and shall come into operation on 1st September 2012.

#### **Fees**

2.—(1) Any manufacturer or dealer of vehicles who causes any notice to be given under section 23A(1) of the Act in connection with any safety-related defect in any vehicle manufactured or sold by him, shall pay to the Authority —

- (a) a fee of \$71.94 (inclusive of GST) for processing every notice and report submitted to the Registrar under section 23A of the Act; and

- (b) a fee of \$1.09 (inclusive of GST) per vehicle for the service rendered by the Authority in providing any information relating to the vehicle for the purpose of the recall of the vehicle.

- (2) Where the fee referred to in paragraph (1) is paid by cheque or electronic fund transfer, and such payment transaction is unsuccessful for any reason, an additional fee of \$21.80 (inclusive of GST) shall be payable to the Authority for each unsuccessful payment transaction.

- (3) The Registrar may waive the fee referred to in paragraph (1) or (2).
