# ROAD TRAFFIC (POWER-ASSISTED BICYCLES) (EXEMPTION FROM PART II) ORDER 2017

#### ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

### Paragraph

- 1. Citation and commencement
- 2. Exemption
- 3. Revocation

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 142 of the Road Traffic Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Order:

#### Citation and commencement

**1.** This Order is the Road Traffic (Power-Assisted Bicycles) (Exemption from Part II) Order 2017 and comes into operation on 14 August 2017.

## **Exemption**

- **2.** Part II of the Act does not apply in respect of a power-assisted bicycle that
  - (a) is registered under the Road Traffic (Registration of Power-Assisted Bicycles) Rules 2017 (G.N. No. S 451/2017), or is kept or used without registration under rule 12 of those Rules;
  - (b) complies with the requirements specified in the Schedule to the Road Traffic (Power-Assisted Bicycles Approval) Rules 2004 (G.N. No. S 768/2004); and
  - (c) is approved and sealed in accordance with the Road Traffic (Power-Assisted Bicycles Approval) Rules 2004.

### Revocation

**3.** The Road Traffic (Power-Assisted Bicycles) (Exemption from Part II) Order 2004 (G.N. No. S 775/2004) is revoked.
