In exercise of the powers conferred by section 142 of the Road Traffic Act 1961, the Minister for Transport makes the following Order:

#### **Citation and period in force**

1.—(1) This Order is the Road Traffic (Alexandra Hospital Shuttle Bus Service — Exemption) Order 2023.

(2) This Order is in force for the period between 7 July 2023 and 31 August 2023 (both dates inclusive).

#### **Definitions**

2. In this Order —

“authorised driver” means an individual authorised by Leisure Frontier (S) Pte. Ltd. (UEN 200717502K) to drive a specified bus;

“part-day bus lane” means a part-day bus lane as described in rule 7(11) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Signs) Rules (R 33);

“specified bus” means a bus bearing any of the following vehicle registration numbers:

- (a) PC9885Z;
- (b) PC9405B;
- (c) PC3172L;
- (d) PC8774S;
- (e) PC3710J;
- (f) PC2607G;
- (g) PC8895B;

“specified bus stop” means the bus stop bearing the bus stop number 11511 and located outside Alexandra Hospital along Alexandra Road.

### **Exemption**

3. Rule 8(1) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Signs) Rules does not apply to any authorised driver who drives a specified bus, or causes or permits a specified bus to remain, on any part-day bus lane along Alexandra Road, for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers at the specified bus stop.
