In exercise of the powers conferred by section 142 of the Road Traffic Act 1961, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Order:

**Citation and period in force**

**1.—(1)** This Order is the Road Traffic (OCBC National Championships 2024 — Individual Time Trial and Team Time Trial — Exemption) Order 2024.

**(2)** This Order is in force —

- (a)** on 4 August 2024 starting 1 a.m. and ending 4 p.m.; and
- (b)** on 1 September 2024 starting 1 a.m. and ending 4 p.m.

**Definitions****2. In this Order —**

“specified event” means any of the following events organised by the Singapore Cycling Federation (UEN S58SS0009A):

- (a) the OCBC National Championships 2024 — Individual Time Trial on 4 August 2024;
- (b) the OCBC National Championships 2024 — Team Time Trial on 1 September 2024;

“specified road” means the road delineated by the black-coloured line in the map set out in the Schedule.

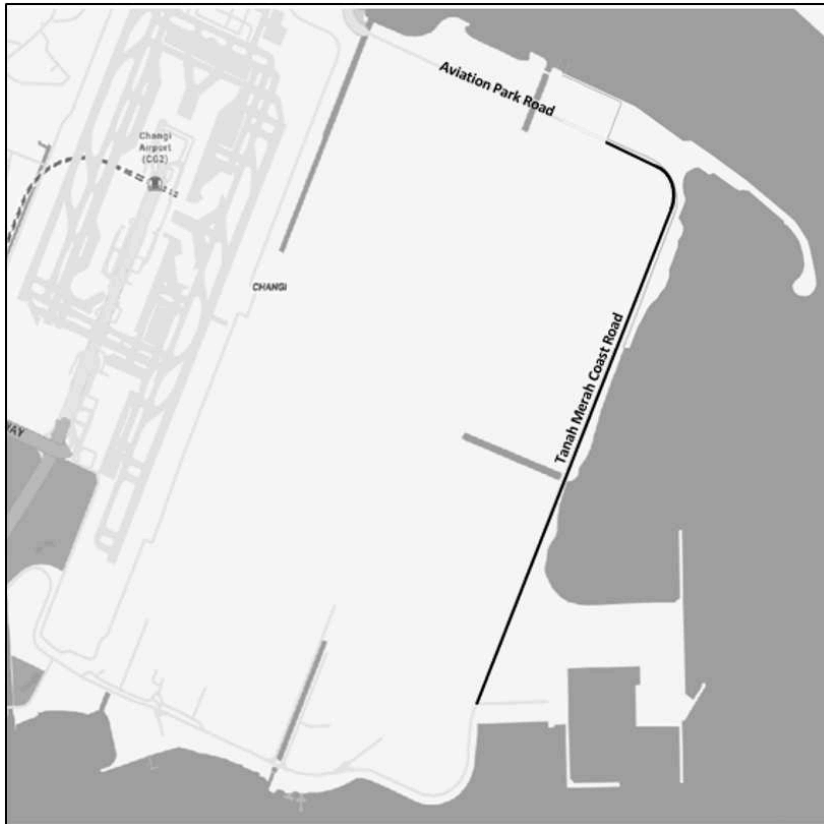
**Exemption for riding bicycle**

**3.** Rules 5, 6, 7, 7A, 7B, 8, 10 and 11 of the Road Traffic (Bicycles, Three-wheeled Pedal Cycles, Trishaws and Recumbent Devices — Road Conduct) Rules (R 3) do not apply to an individual who rides a bicycle on the specified road during and in connection with a specified event.
